Windows: How to change password if you are NOT on the NYSERDA Network.

How to change NYSERDA password if you are:

Running VMware View Horizon agent on a physical PC (from home) or from a laptop.

If you are using the vmware agent while logged into a physical PC/MAC or laptop and need to change the password pressing the CTRL+ALT+DEL keys will issue the command directly to the physical machine you are on, not the VM, here is how to get around that issue.

1. Start VMware, if the vmware application is full screen the toolbar to change the password is "nested" at the top of the screen. Move your mouse to the top of the screen and the tool bar will hover down. If you would rather not move the mouse to the toolbar, you can show the bar by taking the vmware application out of full screen see below:
